

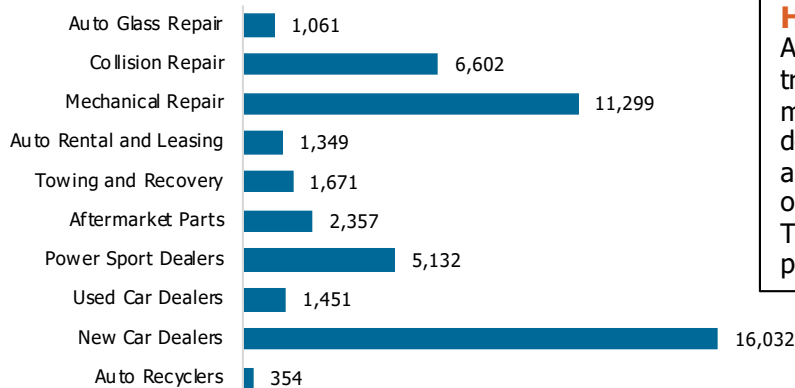

## THE AUTOMOTIVE SECTOR IN BC'S LOWER MAINLAND

### Overview

In 2016 there were approximately **47,308 jobs** in BC's automotive sector. From 2017 to 2026 there will be an estimated **23,117 job openings** in this sector. Two key barriers to filling these positions identified by automotive sector employers are a lack of skills and training related to the automotive sector and a poor public image of the industry. 54% of BC's automotive businesses are in the Southwest Mainland region of BC.\*

### High Demand Occupations

Automotive service technicians, truck and bus mechanics and mechanical repairers are high demand occupations in BC. There are a projected 6,400 job openings in the next 10 years. The median wage of these positions is \$28.00/hour.\*\*

There are two electric car manufacturers in BC:

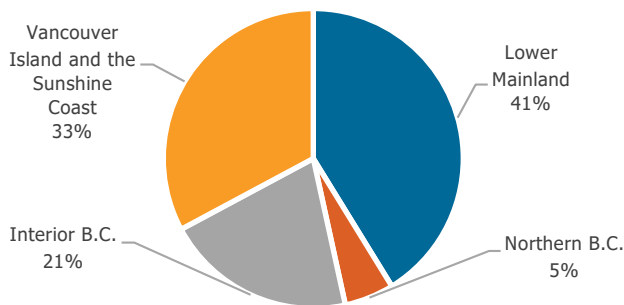
- Canadian Electric Vehicles Ltd in Errington, British Columbia
- Electra Meccanica Vehicles Corp. in Vancouver, British Columbia



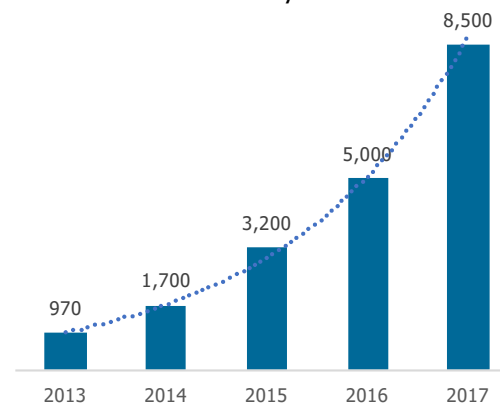
In 2018 **3.5% of cars sold in BC were electric**. Only 40% of car dealerships in BC have electric cars on their lots and waiting times range from 3 to 18 months.\*\*\*

Electric car sales are on the rise in BC. In 2017 there were **6,100 electric cars** on the road in the Lower Mainland.\*\*\*\*
